## **School Yearbook**

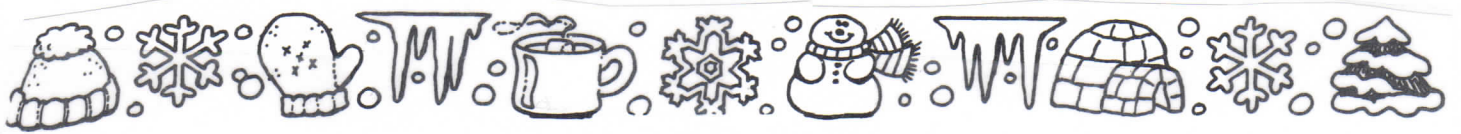
